**European Parliament elections of 9 June 2024**  
European Union (EU) Voters

**EU citizens will be able to vote in European Parliament elections in Spain if they express their desire to do so**

**The deadline to register to vote ends on 30 January 2024**

**The Electoral Census Office will send a communication to 554,774 EU citizens to facilitate this procedure**

Citizens of the European Union (EU) residing in Spain who are 18 or older on voting day will be able to vote in the European Parliament elections of 9 June 2024.

**To vote in these elections, EU citizens must have previously to express their desire to exercise this right.**

Those already registered in the electoral census for previously expressing their intention to vote in Spain will maintain their status as voters without the need to complete a new declaration. This will be the case until they directly request exclusion or leave Spain. To date, there are 286,094 EU voters signed on the electoral roll for European Parliament elections.

**Procedures to express the wish to vote**

EU citizens who want to vote, are registered on the electoral roll and who have not previously expressed a desire to exercise their right to vote in European Parliament elections, may do so by any of the following procedures:

The declaration of will to exercise the right to vote in Spain, in general terms, can be carried out at any time through the Electronic Headquarters of the INE, <https://sede.ine.gob.es/>, if you have a Cl@ve, or by going to the municipality where you are registered, where a form prepared by the Electoral Census Office (OCE) will be provided. This form is also available at the INE Electronic Office and can be completed by citizens before going to their town hall.

In addition, to ease the process, the OCE will send via postal mail a communication to the 554,774 registered voters which have not gone in past elections and haven't express this will. In this communication, a CTT key will be added, which can be used to express the will to vote electronically without the need of a Cl@ve in a new procedure available in the Electronic Headquarters of the INE. A formal declaration will also be added, which can be complemented, signed and resent to the provincial delegation of the corresponding OCE.

Those residing in Spain who are not registered in the Municipal Register must go to their town hall to register and fill out a declaration of will form complementing the effective printed model available at city hall or the electronic headquarters of the INE.

The deadline to express the will to vote in the next European Parliament elections ends on 30 January 2024.

### **Voters and communications to be sent by provinces**

The provinces with the highest number of voters in the EU for European Parliament elections are Madrid (45,289), Barcelona (29,712) and Santa Cruz de Tenerife (24,836).

On the other hand, the provinces with the highest number of mailings to be sent are Barcelona (86,432), Madrid (75,778) and Alicante/Alacant (49,185).
